<i>Single vineyard Prosecco grapes cold pressed left on lees for 3 months to build texture and complexity. hints of pear green apple and spring flowers. Sherbet lemon on the palate remaining clean and pure with a great balance</i>		
Lamberti Prosecco Piedmonte (Italy)		55
<i>Lemon and lime flower on the nose and equally lemon and lime dominated on the palate with green apple crispness Overall crisp, clean and refreshing with just a touch of fruit sweetness.</i>		
Villa Sandi Prosecco Rose' (Italy)	glass 13	59
<i>Overall well balanced lime and rose'scents with a floral tone. Remains fresh vibrant and soft on the palate with natural fruit tones with a medium dry finish</i>		
Lambrusco Di Sorbara (Italy)		79
<i>Historically this grape was savored by the Roman Empire. It grew well and produced during its time great yields. Today this has become a modern sparkling red with crimson hues, a robust fruitiness that remains well balanced. Strikingly fresh and vibrant froth with a flavorsome fruit driven palate that remains clean, crisp with fresh acidity.</i>

<i>'Moet' is characterized by bright fruitiness and elegant maturity. The palate reveals subtle pear, citrus and brioche notes.</i>		

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White Wine

- 12 Signs Semillion Sauvignon Blanc (House White)** **glass 8** **28**
Shiny gold with green hues, the bouquet is quite complex showing honeyed tropical fruits all highlighted with the summery citrus aromas of fresh varietal Semillon. The mellow palate is structured while displaying lively, zesty fruit.
- Twelve Signs Pinot Grigio (NSW)** **glass 9** **29**
Bursting with delightful and appealing lemon peel and soft pears. Taut and linear, the wine is framed by bright acidity and has a long finish.
- Two Rivers Wildfire Unwooded Chardonnay (NSW)** **glass 10** **38**
Wine shows aromas of fresh peach with a subtle lemon citrus lift. The palate is beautifully balanced with good acid and crisp stone fruit flavors.
- Two Rivers Verdelho (NSW)** **49**
Hunter Valley Verdelho lifted musk, stone fruit with strong melon characters evident in this pristinely clean bouquet. A rich Full bodied Verdelho fruit driven with a lingering palate balanced with a soft acidity.
- d'Arenberg Broken Fishplate Sauvignon Blanc (SA)** **62**
The nose is lifted and expressive with tropical fruits dominating. Guava and passion fruit spring to mind. Along with the fruit there are underlying aromatic herb botanicals. On the palate the tropical fruits are joined by cumquat and candied limes and the crisp greenness is reminiscent of crunchy snow peas.
- Scarborough Chardonnay – Pokolbin (NSW)** **65**
Led by peach and lemon and embellished by intense leesy barrel characters that lend complexity. This is much more poised on the palate, it is leaner in fruit profile but still captivates with richness, showing white peach and spicy oak as well as a core of citrus that drives through the finish. Persistent and long, as well as offering keen texture
- Jack and Jill Chardonnay - Scotchmans Hill – Mornington Peninsula (Vic)** **69**
Led by a powerful fruit flavor this chardonnay was hand-picked and whole bunch pressed for slow and gentle juice extraction. Barrel-fermented in 100% French oak for 11 months well integrated with subtle notes of grilled almonds. Hints of grapefruit and nectarine complex and rich whilst retaining its freshness

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White Wine

Stella Bella Estate Chardonnay (WA) 79

Medium intensity of vanilla on the nose with roasted oats almonds peach and apricot with aromas of dried pear and watermelon. On the front palate there is citrus notes with creamy oak flavors. It finishes off as a well-balanced sweet and savory wine.

Petaluma Hanlin Hill Riesling (SA) 89

Pale straw in color, the palate exhibits lemon and grapefruit flavors matched by some fresh and racy acidity.

Devils Lair Chardonnay – Margaret River (WA) 119

Vibrant melon and freshly cut white nectarines are complemented by honey suckle and nougat complexity. Pink grapefruit and pears mingle with white stone fruits. Seamless cashew oak integration finishes with mouth-watering acidity.

Imported & Italian White Wine

Little Angel Sauvignon – Marlborough (NZ) **glass 12** **49**

A combination of modern and traditional winemaking techniques has produced a wine with excellent fruit concentration, crisp acidity and generous texture. Ripe tropical and stonefruit aromas harmonise with capsicum and gooseberry characters. A creamy mouth feel adds backbone to a wine which delivers a long zesty finish.

Gianni Masciarelli Trebiano **49**

A lovely clear wine with a subtle straw yellow hue with greenish reflections. It has an intense bouquet with refined perfume. On the palate it flows elegant apple and apricot flavours and pairs well with game poultry and seafood.

Villa Trasqua Vermentino, Tuscany **glass 14** **53**

A wine with a refreshing acidity and attractive aromas of peach, lemon peel, dried herbs, and a whiff of saline minerality. Dry to medium on the palate with a balanced complexity.

Lamberti Pinot Grigio – Venezia (Italy) **56**

Pale yellow colour; distinctive bouquet of wild flowers, with hints of honey and bananas; dry, but not excessively so, full flavour, soft but fresh and lively, with a pleasing, lingering aftertaste of ripe pears.

Soave Veneto (Italy) **65**

This Soave grape is a very good example of Soave with intense straw yellow colours a fresh, velvety, tasty flavour with pleasant almond note in the finish.

Lama Di Pietra Chardonnay (Italy) **65**

This Chardonnay is cultivated on the northern hills of Bari where the exposure and terroir permits this variety's aromatic content and intensity of fragrances to find their best expressions. The deep fertile soil, of a calcareous and rock nature, forges a balanced wine with a full, fresh flavour.

Livon Pinot Grigio (Italy) **76**

Bright pale straw yellow coloured with slight ash grey reflections. It has a fragrant bouquet with hints of vanilla and lime flowers. On the palate it remains strong with a lingering fresh finish.

Marco Bonfante Gavi Di Gavi (Italy) **92**

Dry white with a pleasant, acidulous freshness. This wine, produced on the Ca del Rosso Estate in Monterotondo di Gavi, reveals itself immediately to be a classy white wine. Its fruity aromas and good structure, obtained thanks to the vineyard's particular soil composition, make this a wine that is highly recommended with fish.

<i>Impressively deep core of juicy forest fruits with balanced ripe tannins. The palate offers full and lasting intensity not often seen at this place.</i>		
Yarrawood Pinot Noir – Yarra Valley (VIC)	<i>glass 11</i>	39
<i>Color purple with crimson hue. Palate – fresh cherry, plum and spice. Aroma – raspberry, violet, plum and subtle oak.</i>		
Geoff Merrill Charley Rose – McLaren Vale (SA)	<i>glass 13</i>	49
<i>An assortment of berry fruits with floral and spice hues. Intensely fruity and succulent on the palate with an appetising dry mineral finish</i>		
d’Arenberg Footbolt Shiraz – McLaren Vale (SA)	<i>glass 13</i>	49
<i>Rich, full-bodied style with aromas of ripe blackberry and spice that mingle with minty peppery notes. The palate is full-flavoured, supple in texture with a velvety finish.</i>		
Tait The Ball Buster- Barossa		63
<i>As the name suggests, it’s a blend of mostly Shiraz with partial quantities of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine is bold and robust with intense aromas of chocolate and black berries whilst remaining smooth with a hint of tannin.</i>		
Paracombe Shiraz Adelaide Hills (SA)		65
<i>This Shiraz was matured for 18 months in French oak. Deep plum colour with wonderful fruit aromas with a delicate cool climate aspect. Notes of cherries and spice with a palate of layered spicy fruit and a fine tannin structure.</i>		
Geoff Merrill Cabernet Sauvignon – McLaren Vale (SA) Vintage	<i>glass 15</i>	70
<i>The color has excellent depth and is very dark red with hints of crimson and mahogany. This Cabernet shows peppermint, violets, leather, black olive, menthol with tasty vanilla and cashew nut characters. The palate is fresh and tight with firm tannins, well balanced acid finishes on a clean fresh fruit note.</i>		
Haan Cabernet/ Merlot – Barossa Valley		75
<i>The aromas of this beautiful wine are earthy, cigar box and a touch of aniseed. Its palate consists of dark berries, earth overtones with a touch of spice. The oak finish is attributed to 12 months of French oak maturation.</i>		

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Red Wine

Stanley Lambert Thoroughbred Cabernet Sauvignon – Barossa Valley 108

Beautifully structured and elegant, rather than overpowering, this Barossa Thoroughbred Cabernet Sauvignon has blackcurrant and plum characters, full of fruit on the palate which follows through with fine tannins and a soft finish.

Penfolds ‘Bin 28’ Kalimna Shiraz (SA) 135

Beautifully lifted red fruits, spicy oak, prune and dates. Well balanced mouth feel, ripe and robust characters of raspberry, and black fruits, chocolate, black licorice and medium tannins. Well-integrated, seasoned oak with a long lingering finish.

d’Arenberg Coppermine Road Cabernet Sauvignon (SA) 148

The nose exhibits classic Cabernet aromatics of black currant leaf, violets, and cigar box with an interesting twist of cooking spice and mustard seed. These lovely savory notes are followed through onto the palate but swept along by an underlying sweet blackcurrant and mulberry fruitiness that builds as the wine continues to evolve in your glass. The initially cedar tannins, start early and give the wine an incredible line. An intriguing fennel note accompanies the chalky tannins that are picked up on the finish, which is long and lingering.

Imported Red Wine

- Solea Merlot – Sicily (Italy)** 49
Deep ruby red wine, it has a fruity aroma with hints of blackberry and red currant. It has a long lasting and wrapping tasting, well structured, with hints of spices matched perfectly with fruit
- Remole Cabernet Sauvignon/Sangiovese – Tuscany (Italy)** 59
A deep, brilliant purple; the bouquet is a dense complex of fruit aromas, such as blackberry, raspberry, cherry, and redcurrant, lifted with fragrant hints of spice and black pepper. The palate is velvet smooth, very warm and rich, with a perfect balance of its components and a refreshing crispness. A long-lingering finish mirrors nicely the fruit on the nose.
- 12 e mezzo, Primitivo Leporano (Italy)** *glass 15* 59
This wine is very elegant with a ruby red colour, intense aromas with fruity scents of ripe plums and cherry jam. Subtle spicy hints finishing with vanilla and cocoa aromatics. Great structure both soft and full of ripe tannins. A typical Italian Zinfandel from some of southern Italy's finest volcanic enriched soils.
- Varaglione Del Salento, Negroamaro (Italy)** 59
Ruby red wine with shades of purple. The nose presents pleasant, facinating scents of wild berries and earthy honey tones. The palate is marked by notes of vanilla with a long persistant fruit that is velvety, soft and elegant
- Lama Di Pierta Nero Di Troia Puglia (Italy)** 65
Black grape vaiety amongst the oldest in the Puglia region. A high altitude vineyard manually Harvested into timber boxes. The grapes are destemmed and fermented in stainless steel vessels producing intense ruby red colour pronounced aromas of raspberry and blueberries with spicy nuances. Good body and structure, lively tannins and an excellent freshness. Medium length finish with an after taste of black fruit.
- Valledoro – Montepulciano, D'Abruzzo (Italy)** 69
Ruby red with purplish highlights, bouquet of ripe red fruit, purplish with spicy touch of cloves and liquorice. Full-bodied, with a good structure and well-integrated soft tannins.

Imported Red Wine

Passimora – Nero Davola, Sicilia (Italy) 69

A delicate aroma of red fruit and pomegranate with sweet notes of dried plum and candied fruit. Soft warm and persistent taste. Grapes go through maceration process then further refined for months in stainless steel.

Chianti Riserva Tuscany DOCG (Italy) 78

The epitome of an Italian classic wine. This splendid Sangiovese grape is typically dry on the palate with a delicate note of fruit that is soft and welcoming. The tannins are gentle and the wine delivers a velvety smooth finish.

Pico Maccario Barbera Piedmonte (Italy) 79

The intense ruby red colours with a charming bouquet exhibiting a wide range of aromas including cherry plum and red berries. Allowed to macerate for 12 days and refined in stainless steel vats for 9 months during which many decantations are implemented. Highly recommended.

Mara Valpolicella Ripasso – Veneto (Italy) 95

Medium ruby colour; dried cherry fruit, sweet, spicy aromas and light wood notes; dry, medium to full bodied, with cherry flavours; a smooth, elegant wine with an aromatic bouquet of ripe fruit and cherries, Cesari Mara Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso boasts a persistent silky, velvety mouthfeel and a warm finish.

Apologno Primitivo Di Salento (Italy) 109

This is a medium to full bodied wine produced from a zinfandel grape which is grown on volcanic soil in the South of Italy 'Lecce'. The wine exhibits a rich long palate with chocolate and fruit spiced nuts and finishes very smooth on the palate. Proven to be a multi award winner.

Rosso Piceno Montepulciano, Marche (Italy) 199

This is a wine, deep purple in colour, very concentrated with juicy red current flavours. Warm and soft on the finish. Highly recommended

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
